About End Hunger Connecticut!

End Hunger CT! is a statewide anti-hunger and food security organization. By focusing on advocacy, outreach, education, and research, EHC! serves as a comprehensive anti-hunger resource for policymakers, community organizations, and low-income families.





About CT Summer Meals

End Hunger CT! conducts statewide promotion of the CT Summer Meals program. We are not a meal site distributing food directly, but we work with sites, partners, businesses, and community members to make sure families know about this important program. CT Summer Meals is federally-funded and part of the USDA's SUN <u>Programs: Summer Nutrition Programs for Kids</u>. SUN Meals (CT Summer Meals) is administered by the Connecticut State Department of Education (CSDE) and provides no-cost, nutritious meals to all children aged 18-and-under throughout the summer. No questions asked, no ID/proof of need is required. Sites serve combinations of breakfast, lunch, supper, and snacks. The program typically distributes more than 1.75 million meals to over 37,000 children 18 and-under at over 600 locations statewide. Families can find the closest meal site near them by accessing the Meal Site Finder at <u>ctsummermeals.org</u>. Powered by the <u>U.S. Department of Agriculture</u> (USDA), the map can show you all the sites near you serving free, healthy meals to all kids 18 and under and is updated weekly with new site information.

CT Summer Meals is a federal SUN Program of the USDA. The map below, powered by USDA, will help you find information about meal sites near you.

Please note that this is a nationwide map controlled by the USDA. <u>If Connecticut sites or a site in your city/town does not</u> <u>yet appear on the map, please check back often.</u> The USDA currently updates the site finder with new state submissions every Friday throughout the summer. Information is updated regularly during the summer months and discontinues when the program ends in late August.






